Objectives & Topics:

This course is an abbreviated version of the RRI's Course 202 and is specifically designed to provide instruction in the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR) and introduction into the Resource Conservation Recovery Act (RCRA) hazardous waste regulations for those personnel who transport non-bulk hazardous wastes. The goal of this course is to identify those additional requirements that apply to RCRA hazardous wastes. The topics covered include acceptable package conditions, package markings, labeling, documentation requirements, vehicle placarding, and acceptable vehicle load configurations. An examination is given at the conclusion of the course.

- Recognize the difference between how RCRA and DOT classify and identify hazardous wastes.
- Identify if a given waste is a RCRA hazardous waste.
- Select the additional markings required on a given package of hazardous waste.
- Determine the required shipping document for a RCRA hazardous waste.
- List the DOT hazardous materials entries necessary for completion of the EPA Uniform Hazardous Waste Manifest.
- Explain what a labpack is and how it affects hazard communications.
- Identify who is responsible for notification and cleanup of releases of hazardous waste in transport.
